

Miles Ramsay was born in Takoma Park, Maryland, in 1941. He attended Cal State University and UCLA, majoring in music while minoring in English. Before finishing his courses he spent the next few years as the lead singer and drummer in a lounge band. He formed a partnership with Brian Gibson & Brian Griffiths in 1965, writing more than four thousand jingles, TV themes, movie scores and commercials for their clientele during the four decades of their partnership. Miles' most famous composition is the Root Bear theme for A&W - a perfect piece for auditioning for a choral singer virtually all his life, lending his vocal talents to the Seattle Mountaineers, Phoenix Chamber Choir, Chor Leoni Men's Choir and others. In 2000, Miles retired from Griffiths Gibson & Ramsay Productions, hopped on the 200 foot tall ship Pictoria and sailed around the world. Upon his return he threw himself back into choral music.
