"In 1989 I nearly died from viral encephalitis, emerging from a coma after fifteen days. I had to learn how to walk and talk again. Few people survive the rare illness and those who do are often severely brain-damaged. During my long convalescence I wrote and arranged a collection of choral music entitled "Songs My Father Taught Me", which was recorded by the West Coast Mennonite Chamber Choir. My

Mom and Dad used to sing songs while we drove to the Okanagan Lake in July, when I was nine. My three younger brothers and I sang along.
