Philippe Petit is the French high-wire artist who gained fame erial walk between the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City on August 7, 1974. For his norized feat 400 metres above the ground he and his team successfully rigged 200 kilograms of cable between buildings without getting caught. Petit performed for 45 minutes, making 8 passes along the wire.
