incommunicado: *not able, wanting, or allowed to communicate* / people.

Incommunicado is designed for easy and intuitive memorization. Singers can add movement and play music on the cellphone) The composition, meant to be fun and gimmicky, has a sage. We've all experienced unwelcome noise at a choral concert. Also, singers sometimes miss the joy of singing, taking 's too seriously.

Listen to John Cage's 4'33" - which illustrates the co-dependency of our modern society.

My daughter and her husband have a log cabin on a mountain, 30 minutes from downtown Vancouver. (no electricity or running water!) After a short hike, one can experience the silence of the woods. It's a great place to shut off the world for a while and go "incommunicado". (just remember to turn off the phone)

choreography ideas: keep gestures simple and expressive. For example, at m. 26 the singers could stand tall with hands clasped at sternum level (one palm up and one palm down).
