He is the winner of the 2002 Ruth Watson Henderson Award for his motet Peace, and he is a three-time recipient of first prize awards in the Association of Canadian Choral Conductor's Composition Competitions for his music for treble voices and piano (2000, 2002, 2004.) He has been commissioned and performed by many of Canada's finest choirs and by the CBC. His works have been performed, recorded, and broadcast across North America, Europe, and Asia, and he has approximately fifty published compositions and arrangements.
