"O Siem" is a song written by Inuit musician Susan Aglukark and Chad Irschick. It was recorded by Aglukark on her 1995 album "This Child" and was released that year as the album's first single. The song went to number one on both the RPM country and adult contemporary charts, and peaked at number three on the pop chart.

"O Siem", meaning a joyful love for family and loved ones, was "an anthem against racism and prejudice" according to Historica Canada. It called for inclusivity and acceptance, the things that Aglukark has spent her life promoting.

Born on January 27, 1967, Aglukark was born in the Northwest Territories, now Nunavut. Her childhood love for music by singing in her father's choir and playing guitar at summer camp.

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
