David Francey is a Scottish-born Canadian carpenter-turned-songwriter, who has become one of Canada's most revered folk poets and singers" (Toronto Star). Born in Glasgow, Scotland to parents who were factory workers, he moved to Canada in 1962. For decades, he worked across Canada in rail yards, construction and in the Yukon bush, all the while writing poetry, setting it to melodies in his songs and singing it to himself as he worked. A truly authentic folk singer, Francey is a true maverick of the working person who never imagined earning a living from his music.

When he was in his 40s, his wife, artist Beth Girdler, encouraged him to share his songs and sing in public. The reaction was instant. His first album *Torn Screen Door* came out in 1999 and was a hit in Canada. Since then, he has released eleven albums, won three Juno Awards and has had his songs covered by such artists as The Del McCoury Band, The Rankin Family, James Keelaghan and Tracy Grammer.
