Dr. Benjamin Bolden, (b. 1971) music educator and composer, began his musical career singing in a church boys' choir, and has been singing in choirs ever since. He has also performed in rock bands, concert bands, gamelan ensembles, and for ten years in professional music theatre. Ben studied composition at Carleton University with Patrick Cardy, at UBC with Stephen Chatman, and at the University of Toronto with Christos Hatzis. He has composed for strings, orchestra, wind ensemble, opera, and more, but the majority of his work has been composed for choirs. In 2016 Ben won the Choral Canada Competition for Choral Writing. Ben is an associate professor and the UNESCO Chair of Arts and Learning in the Faculty of Education at Queen's University, Canada. As a teacher, Ben has worked with pre-school, elementary, secondary, and university students in Canada, England, and Taiwan.
