Ways to practice some of these sounds

k^{W}

First do a few regular [k] sounds; notice how your lips are relaxed. Then do a few more [k] sounds but this time round your lips (like when saying 'oo')

٧W

First do the <**ch**> in 'J. S Ba**ch**'. Continue doing it, but now round your lips like when saying 'oo'

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Besides thinking of a lisp, you can think of it as a <s> with the air coming out the sides of the tongue rather than through the front

a

Beware: it is *not* the <a> in 'cat' or in 'ball' but somewhere in between; as in the first part of the diphthong 'mouth'. Say 'mouth' but pause on the first vowel (before the change to 'oo')
