She received a Bachelor of Music degree, Honours Voice, from the University of Western Ontario, then moved to Toronto to sing in the Elmer Is [redacted] (EIS), one of Canada's professional choirs. While on tour in Nova Scotia, Mary Lynne met [redacted], Paul Whyte. Mary Lynne has enjoyed being an at-home mom to two sons while establishing [redacted] career in singing, teaching voice, and conducting, especially through Dublin Street United [redacted] Guelph, ON where her membership resided for twenty years. Mary Lynne learned to [redacted] discerning a call to 'minister musically' in the Guelph area, which she did for 6 years until [redacted] the Canadian navy and they moved to Victoria, BC for Paul's officer training. This is when [redacted] Lynne began to feel a call to Ordered Ministry. Once Paul was posted to Halifax, she brought [redacted] discernment through Stairs Memorial United Church in Dartmouth.

Mr. [redacted] deeply grateful to Rev.
