Dr. Larry Nickel nearly died from viral encephalitis in 1989 and emerged from a coma after fifteen days. During a long convalescence Larry wrote and arranged 22 pieces. He took director Tony Funk out for breakfast one day and proposed a recording project which eventually became the "Songs My Father Taught Me" collection - recorded by a new choir (formed especially for the project). The West Coast Mennonite Chamber Choir continued to sing and record together - producing 13 CDs over 15 years, including 120 of Larry's compositions. Proceeds from CD sales, totalling nearly one million dollars, were donated to Communitas Supportive Care Services, which cares for disabled people.
